

# REACH Declaration

REACH is a European Community Regulation on chemicals and their safe use (EC 1907/2006). It deals with the **R**egistration, **E**valuation, **A**uthorization and **R**estriction of **C**hemical substances. The new law entered into force on 1 June 2007 and will be phased in until 2018. The aim of REACH is to further improve the protection of human health and the environment through the better and earlier identification of certain chemical substances. It is legislation from the European Union, and applies to all suppliers (inside and outside Europe) who want to sell, import or manufacture chemicals and/or products containing certain chemicals into the European Union.

Planar supports the objective of REACH to further improve the European Union's regulation on chemicals, including the aim to advance public health and safety and to protect the environment. The limited number of chemicals that we import ourselves at our Espoo, Finland EL glass facility has been entered into the pre-registration process already. Additionally, we have requested our component or finished products suppliers to provide us information on the relevant chemicals in their supplied products. This enables us to provide our customers with information about designated substances of very high concern (SVHC), as required by article 33 of REACH (if those are present in a concentration of more than 0.1% of the weight of a product).

Planar Systems Inc. is committed to working with our suppliers and customers to ensure continued supply of our products. We do not anticipate any disruptions of product supplies to our customers. Based on our internal assessment using available guidance and statements from our suppliers, we believe that none of our products contain substances that are intended to be released under normal and reasonable foreseeable conditions of use with the possible below exceptions.

The below table indicates which substance(s) of very high concern (SVHC) may be present in Planar products above the threshold level of 0.1% by weight of the listed article. As we continue to introduce new products, collect data from our suppliers, or as the various phases of REACH are implemented this table will be updated.
